



God gave me this message in August. He put it on my heart to share it with you .

August 10, 2024. There are going to be problems in this nation that we have never seen. There's going to be a lot of destruction. The world isn't going to look the same. We need to be in tune with God, spending time with Him studying His Word, hearing His voice, hearing the Holy Spirit, listening for divine instructions and confirmation. We need to be asking God for wisdom and discernment. We need to "**go ye therefore and teach all nations, baptizing them**", laying hands on the sick, casting out demons. We need to be planting seeds.

We need to repent. Many Christians today have hard hearts. God can't do the work He wants to do in your heart if it's hard. He wants the body of Christ to turn back to Him. (return to your 1st love). He's not pleased with every person. He's not pleased with His body. We talk about how we want Jesus to come back, but we're not prepared. John 3:17 says God doesn't want ANY to perish, but ALL to have everlasting life. Much of the body would perish if Jesus came today. That's because we want to be like the world. The church has become a worldly place---worldly music, worldly things happening in the church, worldly people. God's people are supposed to be set apart. We're not supposed to look like the world. We're not supposed to do the things of the world. Jeremiah 10:2, God says, "**do not learn the ways of the nations**". And this is exactly what the church has done. 1 Peter 4:17 says, "*For the time has come that judgment must begin at the house of God. and if it begins with us, **what will be the outcome for those who do not obey the gospel of God? And if the righteous is scarcely saved, what will become of the ungodly and the sinner? Therefore let those who suffer according to God's will entrust their souls to a faithful Creator while doing good.***" We're going to be judged by our works. James said , "*show me your faith without works and I will show you my faith BY my works.*" If you're not showing your faith by doing works, you don't have faith. If you're not doing good, not obeying God and the gospel, you will stand before Yeshua and hear Him say "**I never knew you. Depart from me, you workers of lawlessness.**" He said that many would stand before Him on that day and call Him Lord, but He would not be their Lord. Why? Because they didn't abide in Him. They didn't keep the commandments of God. Sin is defined as lawlessness in 1 John 3:4. Sin is breaking the Law of God. "**Everyone who makes a practice of sinning also practices lawlessness; sin is lawlessness. You know that he appeared in order to take away sins, and in him there is no sin. No one who abides in him keeps on sinning; no one who keeps on sinning has either seen him or known him. Little children, let no one deceive you. Whoever practices righteousness is righteous, as he is righteous. Whoever makes a practice of sinning is of the devil, for the devil has been sinning from the beginning. The reason the Son of God appeared was to destroy the works of the devil. No one born of God makes a practice of sinning, for God's seed abides in him; and he cannot keep on sinning, because he has been born of God. By this it is evident who are the children of God, and who are the children of the devil: whoever does not practice righteousness is not of God, nor is the one who does not love his brother.**" This is the purpose of the Law. To show us what righteousness is. This is one of the reasons Yeshua came. To teach us how to keep it because we had forgotten! Yeshua told us in John 14:10, "**IF you keep my commandments, you will abide in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and abide in his love.**" HE said to obey His commandments multiple times.

Yeshua was teaching that not everyone who calls Him Lord will enter the Kingdom. He said, "**the one who does the will of My Father.**" And Yeshua said, "**I have not come to do My own will, but the will of My Father.**" Jesus kept the Torah, the Law perfectly. If he would not have done that, He would not be the Messiah. He had to be the perfect Passover Lamb.

John 12:49 ***“For I have not spoken on my own authority, but the Father who sent me has himself given me a commandment—what to say and what to speak.”***

What is the will of the Father? That we obey His Law! God’s Law is His protection. The enemy comes to confuse this. He has confused a lot of people that we don’t have to do what God says, **but we DO need to do what God says.** There is ONE Law and it is the royal Law of God’s royal Kingdom. Micah 4 and Isaiah 2 say that in the Millennial Kingdom, the Torah (instructions, Law) of God will go out of Zion. God has already given us His will. It is His Torah, His instructions. Yeshua kept it perfectly, Paul kept it, the disciples kept it. But we’ve been convinced that we don’t have to! We’ve been convinced that Paul didn’t keep it and taught that we didn’t have to. He was accused of this and in Acts 21, he took a Nazarite vow to prove He was teaching the Torah. The Nazarite vow comes from the Torah.

We’ve been convinced that we can’t keep the commandments, so why even try? But what did God say? Deut 30:11,14 ***“For this commandment that I command you today is not too hard for you, neither is it far off. The word is very near to you. It is in your mouth and in your hearts, so that you CAN do it.”*** God says “the Word” for His Law. His Word is His Law. He says His Word will not return to Him void. God never changes. His Word never changes. Yeshua is the ***“same yesterday, today and forever.”*** His Kingdom operates by Law. It is consistent. There are laws that God created. The Law of Gravity. If you jump out of a plane, and you don’t have a parachute, you will die. It’s the same thing if you break God’s Law.

But we’ve been deceived into thinking Yeshua was someone else in the Old Testament and that God was a different God in the Old Testament. That He wasn’t a God of grace. All we have to do is read the story of the children of Israel and we see how much grace He gave them over and over again! He sent prophets to them to warn them, but they didn’t listen. He gave them His Torah (instructions) as an inheritance, but they thought they didn’t have to keep it, because they didn’t believe God. He said that if they rebelled and disobeyed, He would bring curses and death. But He said if they obeyed, He would bring blessings and life. **Many of them did not believe Him and Romans 11 said they were broken off b/c of unbelief.** They thought He would just continue in grace, but He didn’t let a whole generation go into the promised land. He exiled people, people died, and it was because they rebelled and they disobeyed. I want us to see what Paul says about this: 1 Cor 10:5-6: ***“Nevertheless, with most of them God was not pleased, for they were overthrown in the wilderness. Now these things took place as examples for us, that we might not desire evil as they did.*** Verses 11-12 says: ***Now these things happened to them as an example, but they were written down for our instruction, on whom the end of the ages has come. Therefore let anyone who thinks that he stands take heed lest he fall.*** “ If we think we can be lawless and stand, we are deceiving ourselves.

Many of us claim to be New Covenant believers. So, we’re going to look at the New Covenant. Jeremiah 31:31-33. ***“Behold, the days are coming, declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah, not like the covenant that I made with their fathers on the day when I took them by the hand to bring them out of the land of Egypt, my covenant that they broke, though I was their husband, declares the Lord. For this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, declares the Lord: I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts. And I will be their God, and they shall be my people.”*** Now we’re going to look at Ezekiel. Ezekiel 36:22-28. ***“Therefore say to the house of Israel, Thus says the Lord God: It is not for your sake, O house of Israel, that I am about to act, but for the sake of my holy name, which you have profaned among the nations to which you came. And I will vindicate the holiness of my great name, which has been profaned among the***

nations, and which you have profaned among them. And the nations will know that I am the Lord, declares the Lord God, when through you I vindicate my holiness before their eyes. I will take you from the nations and gather you from all the countries and bring you into your own land. I will sprinkle clean water on you, and you shall be clean from all your uncleanness, and from all your idols I will cleanse you. And I will give you a new heart, and a new spirit I will put within you. And I will remove the heart of stone from your flesh and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put my Spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes and be careful to obey my rules. You shall dwell in the land that I gave to your fathers, and you shall be my people, and I will be your God.” Yeshua didn’t come to make us lawless, He came to do the opposite.

The New Covenant is Yeshua coming to die so our sins could be forgiven, so we could no longer be law breakers, so we could have eternal life, and so He could send the Holy Spirit to us to cause us to obey His statutes and rules and He could write His Law on our minds and hearts.

God will judge his own people before He judges the unbelievers. We have a higher responsibility to obey God and avoid sin. The church is filthy right now. But God is cleaning house. He’s removing those He didn’t put in positions and He’s using this to bring the body to repentance. We’ve had our eyes closed for so long, but God is opening the eyes of His people.

God is a God of love and mercy, but He’s also a God of wrath and judgment. People want to hear a easy “itching ears” gospel, but Yeshua didn’t teach the gospel was easy. He taught that we would suffer, that we would have to persevere and that those who endure to the end would be saved. This is what He told the 7 churches of Revelation. He said we would have to destroy our lives to follow Him. People are not preaching enough of the message that **God will have to bring wrath and judgment for our iniquity. God is speaking repentance right now. He’s speaking correction, turning away from sin. Turning away from the world and its ways.** Getting our hearts and minds right.

THIS WAS A WARNING. We need to be prepared. Yeshua told a parable about 10 virgins. 5 were wise and 5 were foolish. **ALL TEN THOUGHT they were going to be with the bridegroom, but only 5 were prepared. Those that weren’t prepared did not get to go with the bridegroom.** Many of Yeshua’s teachings were warnings. He’s not speaking a tickling ears message. There are consequences for sin, and there’s consequences for not being prepared. If you’re not prepared, if you’re not spending time with God, if you’re not studying to show yourself approved, you will not be in the Kingdom. Actions matter. God doesn’t grade with a curve. You either pass or fail. That doesn’t mean He’s bad. He gives us grace and mercy and He’s given so much. **But believers, we have given so little!** We need to take heed. A loving Father has to bring judgment on sin. He is a holy God. He cannot be near sin. **This means He doesn’t want worldly things in His house—worldly music, worldly entertainment, worldly people.** He has to remove sin from His church. HE is coming for a bride—not a whore!!!! **God is trying to wake us up!** Will you repent? Will you do the will of your Father? Will you keep His commandments? Will you live a holy ,righteous, set apart life? Will you stand before Yeshua and hear Him say **“I never knew you, workers of lawlessness”** or will you hear Him say **“Well done, good and faithful servant.”**

If we choose to go our own way, what will be the result? Proverbs 14:12 says, **“There is a way that seems right to a man, but the end thereof is the way of death.”** So if we think our way is the best way, we’re being deceived. Jeremiah 17:9 says, **“The heart is deceitful above ALL things and beyond cure.”**

If we are faithful, we believe and obey. Will you obey your Father? Will you make Him your Father? I'm asking all of you to repent and return to God and His ways. we need to STOP following men and start following Yeshua. Start studying your Word and immerse yourself in it. Yeshua told us to follow Him. This is a commandment.

You have a decision to make. You either have to step into God's Kingdom completely or you have decided to align yourself with the enemy. You can't walk in the gray area or on the line, because the enemy owns them. Will you step out by faith into God's Kingdom and obey Him? Will you obey Yeshua? Will you obey God like He did? Will you follow Him?
